2012 T. Boone Pickens Lifetime Sportsman Award

On March 8, 2012 the Park Cities Quail organization will present Ted Turner with the T. Boone Pickens Lifetime Sportsman Award. This dinner/auction/fundraiser will be held at the Frontiers of Flight museum at Love Field. We expect 1,000 people at this year's event and tables/individual seats are going quick. T. Boone Pickens will be on hand to present the award and he will join Ted Turner in a lively presentation for the crowd on their personal experiences in wildlife and habitat management. The live and silent auctions will have items for every price range, from \$100,000 hunts on Mr. Pickens Mesa Vista Ranch (private jet ride included) to a private cigar party at Up In Smoke, game feeders, guns, etc.

Park Cities Quail (PCQ) is a Dallas based non-profit focused on supporting quail hunting in Texas. Over the last 4 years, PCQ has raised and donated over \$1.9 million to quail research. These funds support the Rolling Plains Quail Research Foundation (RPQRF) and the Texas Bobwhite Brigade. The RPQRF is a 4,700 acre research and demonstration facility near Roby, TX used to foster understanding and management of bobwhite and blue quail. Dr. Dale Rollins, Professor and Texas A&M Agrilife Extension Wildlife Specialist runs the facility. The Bobwhite Brigade is a wildlife focused leadership development program for high school youth dedicated to habitat management, communication skills and developing a land ethic.
