1. All Membership applications must be approved by the Membership Chairman and the Board of Directors of the Dallas Gun Club.
2. All references will be personally contacted by the Membership Chairman.
3. **An application fee of \$100 must accompany each application at the time of submission. This fee is non-refundable but will be applied to the initiation fee upon acceptance. In the event there is a waiting list the application fee will entitle the applicant to remain on the waiting list until a membership opening is offered to the applicant. If the applicant does not complete the application process when offered an additional \$100 fee must be paid to remain on the waiting list.**
4. Payment for the Initiation Fee, sales tax and dues to next billing period must be paid at the time of interview.
5. We are required by the State of Texas to collect sales tax on the Initiation Fee and on dues.
6. Dues are payable in advance in March and September of each year. Dues may be changed by the Board of Directors at any time.

NOTE: A Junior Membership expires on the Junior Member's 36th birthday. A Junior Member may convert his/her membership to a Resident Membership at any time in accordance with the Bylaws and the Rules, Policies and Operating Guidelines.

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JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

- (1) A Junior Member must be between the ages of 21 and 35 years of age. Except as otherwise set forth below, a Junior Member becomes ineligible for Junior Membership upon his/her 36th birthday.
- (2) The initiation fee for a Junior Member shall be 50% of the initiation fee payable by a Resident Member on the date that the Junior Member joins the Club (currently \$8,000). The initiation fee for a Junior Membership shall be payable as follows:
 - (i) \$1,000 shall be due and payable at the time of acceptance of the membership.
 - (ii) The balance of the initiation fee shall be payable in equal installments over the lesser of (A) the next ten (10) dues billing cycles (5 years), or (B) the number of billing cycles remaining until the Junior Member reaches his/her 36th birthday.
 - (iii) Initiation fees for Junior Members shall be non-refundable but may be applied to the initiation fee for a Resident Membership if the Junior Member applies for and is accepted as a Resident Member.
- (3) Junior Members must pay full monthly dues at the same rate and on the same dates as Resident Members – currently \$195 per month (subject to change by the Board). Dues are billed 2 times a year-- March and September.
- (4) Junior Members shall be entitled to all privileges of membership in the Club including use of the clubhouse, grounds, and facilities; *provided, however*, Junior Members may not vote or hold office as an officer or director of the Club.
- (5) Junior Memberships may not be sold or transferred.
- (6) Upon the death of a Junior Member, his/her membership shall automatically terminate as of the date of death.
- (7) The Club shall not make any refund of dues or initiation fees upon the termination of any Junior Membership.
- (8) A Junior Member may apply to become a Resident Member at any time prior to his/her 36th birthday. Upon acceptance as a Resident Member, the Junior Member shall pay the difference between the initiation fees previously paid by such Junior Member and the initiation fee in effect for a Resident Membership on the date that the Junior Member joined the Club as a Junior Member.
- (9) If a Junior Member desires to continue to use the Club beyond his/her 36th birthday, then prior to his/her 36th birthday, a Junior Member must (i) apply to become a Resident Member, (ii) pay the difference between the initiation fees previously paid by such Junior Member and the initiation fee in effect for a Resident Membership on the date that the Junior Member joined the Club as a Junior Member, and (iii) continue to pay full monthly dues at the same rate and on the same dates as Resident Members. If a Junior Member has complied with the foregoing, he/she may continue use of the Club facilities until a Resident Membership becomes available. If a Junior Member has failed to comply with the foregoing as of his/her 36th birthday, his/her membership shall terminate on his/her 36th birthday.
